

SHOPPING TOUR IN MILANO **THE CITY OF FASHION!**

Duration: 6 days / 4 nights

Period: January 2006



DAY 1 – Wed, Jan 11: DEPARTURE FROM USA

Departure from USA. Flight journey.

DAY 2 – Thu, Jan 12: ARRIVAL IN MILANO / TSF TO THE HOTEL

Arrival in Milano. Transfer by private de-luxe coach from the airport to the hotel for accommodation. Time at your disposal for your shopping tour. Dinner and overnight in the hotel.

DAY 3 – Fri, Jan 13: MILANO, HALF DAY GUIDED VISIT + SHOPPING TOUR



Breakfast in the hotel. Half day guided visit of Milano, you can choose between: Leonardo's tour discovering the masterpieces he left in Milan during his stay here from 1482 till 1513. Visit the Sforza Castle, a huge brick quadrilateral building, which used to be the seat of the Dukes of Milan. Inside is the room of the Axes in the Falconiera Tower decorated by Leonardo and a permanent Exhibition which displays the statue Pietà Rondanini, one of the Prisons' by

Michelangelo. The tour will go on to Santa Maria delle Grazie which houses the world-wide famous "Last Supper" fresco by Leonardo.

Or: city sightseeing tour to the main Cathedral, a marvel of white marble, bristling with belfries, gables, hundreds of pinnacles and statues. At the top of the central tower stands a small gilt statue, the Madonnina from 1774, a symbol of Milan. The elegant Vittorio Emanuele 2nd Gallery designed from Giuseppe Mengoni in 1864, the worldwide famous Scala Opera House (outside).

Free lunch and free afternoon. Possibility to spend the evening at the Scala Opera House, enjoying a Ballet, an Opera, a Concert or a Recital. Return to the hotel on your own, dinner and overnight.



**DAY 4 – Sat, Jan 14:
MILANO, FULL DAY SHOPPING TOUR**



Breakfast in the hotel. Free lunch and full day free time. You can do shopping in Via Torino and Corso Vittorio Emanuele, or reach the outlet stores and stock houses full of the most famous fashion brands. In late afternoon if you wish you can enjoy a typical aperitif at one of the trendy Milanese lounge bars, some of them attended by models and VIP people. The aperitif started off in Milano and it's become very trendy, it includes a cocktail or beer or glass of wine and a big

buffet to sample different kinds of food, like pasta, risotto, vegetables, pizzas, focaccia, olives, omelettes, etc...
Return to the hotel on your own, dinner and overnight.

**DAY 5 – Sun, Jan 15:
MILANO, FULL DAY SHOPPING TOUR**

Breakfast in the hotel. Free lunch and full day free time. Discover the Milanese Fashion District: Via Montenapoleone, Via della Spiga, Corso Venezia e Via Sant'Andrea.

Return to the hotel on your own, I suggest to have typical dinner in one of the traditional Milanese restaurants in Navigli area, then enjoy a brief stroll around, and maybe a nice concert or cabaret in one of the many venues spotted around. Return to the hotel on your own (taxi), for overnight.



**DAY 6 – Mon, Jan 16:
DEPARTURE**

Breakfast in the hotel. In the morning transfer by de- luxe coach to the airport for departure.

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
